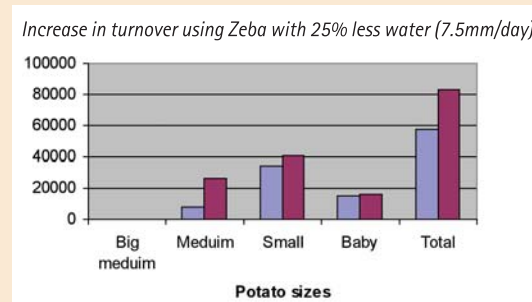
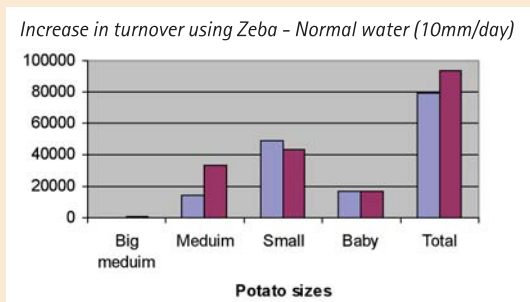
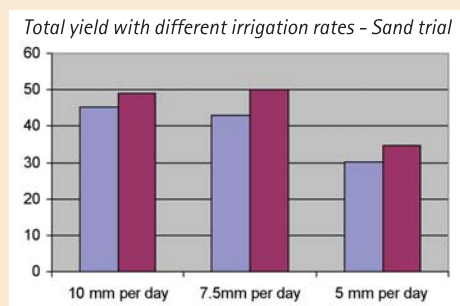

**Trial protocol:**  
Trial was done to determine the effect of Zeba on potato yields during normal irrigation as well as reduced rates. Normal irrigation (control) was set at 10mm per day and water was reduced by 25% and 50% respectively.

**Trial conclusion:**

### What is Zeba®?

### How does Zeba work?

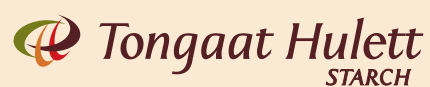
Zeba absorbs up to 400 times its own weight in water and releases 95% back to the plant. Rain or irrigation hydrates Zeba, preventing moisture from leaching or evaporating. Moisture is therefore available to the plant when required. Zeba reduces irrigation by up to 30%. Zeba also absorbs fertiliser and releases it to the plant when needed.

### Is Zeba suitable for any soil type?

Yes. In sandy soil Zeba will retain water and fertiliser which would otherwise have leached out. In clayish soil Zeba will help to aerate the soil as the product expands and contracts.

### How is Zeba applied?

Zeba is band placed in the planting row at the same depth as fertiliser (10-15cm), using a Gandy applicator. Application rate: Approximately 8kg per hectare.
